Additional responsibilities

- Lead the development and delivery of all CPD activity inc. SDF Events and others.
- Liaise with the Council and Executive in order to progress the SDF's strategies and business plan targets.
- Looking for opportunities to expand and develop projects within the region of benefit to members and Higher Education as a whole.

Support from the SDF

- Networking and knowledge exchange as part of the SDF Council.
- Communicating with the local Region members, passing on key information.
- Managing Regional Jiscmail to enable local network support.
- Update the SDF regional network page when required.
